CARNIVAL RULES AND BOOKLET

Check In

All associations to check in at the Control Desk in the Clubhouse at the beginning of the Carnival to check for any changes in the draw.

Draw

The draw will be sent out prior to the carnival and available in Netball Connect.

Game Times

11-12 Yrs

All games will consist of four 10-minute quarters with a 2-minute break at quarter times and 3-minute break at half time and 8 minutes between games. No injury time is recorded.

13-14 Yrs

All games will consist of four 12-minute quarters with a 2-minute break at quarter times and 3-minute break at half time and 10 minutes between games. No injury time is recorded.

Netball Australia playing rules and blood rules apply. All games will be timed from the Control Desk at the Clubhouse.

First Aid

A First Aid officer will be available at the First Aid Station inside the Clubhouse. If an Ambulance is required the First Aid Officer or MacGregor Official will make the call. All injuries are to be recorded with the injury form located at Control.

Umpiring

All teams must supply a suitably qualified and attired umpire for each game. All umpires will umpire the court next to theirs eg Court 7 will umpire Court 10.

Uniforms

All players must be in correct uniform and with correctly positioned patches.

Score Sheets

Score sheets will be paper and available from the Control Desk on a clipboard with the game ball. The WINNING team is to return the score sheet, clipboard and game ball at the end of the game to the Control Desk. Scores will be updated on Netball Connect by MacGregor.

Each team are required to supply a scorer who must stand together in the centre of the sideline. Each scorer will sign the score sheet and this will be the final score. No dispute shall be accepted if a team has not supplied a scorer for the entire game.

Points

Two points will be awarded for a win and one point for a draw. If a team wins by Forfeit they will receive 2 points and no goals will be awarded and there is 0 points for a BYE. The overall winner of each division will be determined by their points at the end of the competition. If tied, the winning team will be decided by goal difference.

Questions or Issues During Games

If there are any questions or concerns during the competition, please inform your players and supporters to contact your officials first. MacG Control Desk is available to receive concerns during the game from a Representative of your Club/Association.

Presentations

Medals will be awarded to 12-14 Year Divisions for the winners, runners up and third. All players competing in the 11 Years Division will receive a Participation Medal. Presentations will take place after the end of the last round on Sunday.

Food/Dining

There will be a variety of food and drink options available during the Cup including Canteen, Café, BBQ and Snow Cones. Cash and EFTPOS available. Sunnybank Community Sports Club has dining options available for lunch and dinner (bookings recommended).

Warm Up Areas

There are four top courts available for teams to warm up (see the map).

Tents

Player and Official Tents

Each association/club has been allocated a set space as per requests (see the map).

Important: Player and official tent space will be on bitumen. It is recommended all players and officials bring their own seating (eg camping chairs). Teams bringing their own tents must be able to secure their tents using weights (eg sand or water weights).

Supporter Tents

Space around the courts has been allocated for supporter tents/shade structures (see the map). All tents must be secured with weights or pegs for safety.

Please do not put tents or shade structures on any of the grass courts.

Rubbish & Recycling

Rubbish and bottle recycling bins will be available around the grounds. Please support our association by helping to keep our grounds and amenities tidy.

Toilets

Toilets for females, males and disabled are situated near the clubhouse. Please remind your players and supporters to be respectful using these facilities and inform the Control Desk if there are any concerns.

Parking

Parking is available on site (ease of access from Granadilla St). No parking on the cricket side on Saturday. Please be respectful of our parking volunteers.

Spectators

All spectators are asked to move around the outside of the courts and not between. Please refer to the map for spectator seating and tent locations and ensure that you leave the area behind the team boxes clear.

Rolling substitutions

Rolling substitutions will be used during the SCSC Cup.

- Each team will have two (2) sets of bibs of the same colour.
- Each team will have a designated team substitution zone on the sideline of the court out of the umpire's way.
- The on-court player must leave the court observing all on-court rules (eg. Offside).
- The on-court player taps hands with the Substitute player. (The substitute player should already be fitted with the bib to take the court. Should only one set of bibs be available the substitute player must have put the bib on completely before entering the court.)
- The substitution player then enters the court observing the on-court rules (eg.
 Offside) and must not obstruct the umpire.
- Should the substitution not be made correctly, a free pass will be awarded to the nonoffending team as long as it does not disadvantage them.


